Sub: Filling up of the post of '**Judicial Member**' in the Karnataka State Administrative Tribunal.

The Government of Karnataka have created two additional benches of Karnataka State Administrative Tribunal at Belagavi and Kalaburagi. It is proposed to fill up the post of '**Judicial Member**', one each at these benches along with one post of Judicial Member which will fall vacant in Bengaluru Bench from June 2018.

2. The eligibility criteria for appointment as '**Judicial Member**' as stipulated in section 6(2)(b) of the Administrative Tribunals (Amendment) Act, 2006 is as follows:-

"6(2)(b) A person shall not be qualified for appointment as a Judicial Member unless he is or qualified to be a Judge of a High Court or he has for at least two years held the post of a Secretary to the Government of India in the Department of Legal Affairs or the Legislative Department including Member-Secretary, Law Commission of India or held a post of Additional Secretary to the Government of India in the Department of Legal Affairs and Legislative Department at least for a period of five years."

3. The Term of office and the conditions of services of '**Judicial Member**' as stipulated in sections 8(2) and (3) of the Administrative Tribunals (Amendment) Act, 2006 is as follows:-

"8 (2) A Member shall hold office as such for a term of five years from the date on which he enters upon his office extendable by one more term of five years;

Provided that no Member shall hold office as such after he has attained the age of sixty-five years.

(3) The conditions of service of Chairman and Members shall be the same as applicable to Judges of the High Court."

4. The person appointed to the office of the Judicial Member is liable to be posted or transferred to any of the Benches of Karnataka State Administrative Tribunal on rotation basis.
5. Selection, appointment and condition of service to the post of Judicial member shall be subject to result in Writ Petition(Civil) No. 279/2017 and connected cases pending on the file of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
6. You are therefore requested kindly to send the names of the eligible persons including retiring Judges of High Court and the Members of the Bar who have special knowledge and experience in service laws and are willing to be considered for the post of Judicial Member in the Karnataka State Administrative Tribunal along with their bio-data in the enclosed proforma. It is requested that the names may be sent to The Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms latest by:**04.04.2018**. In the case of candidates other than Members of the Bar, their CR's for the last ten years and vigilance clearance may also be sent.
